**Prehistoric tools made from a mixture of materials**

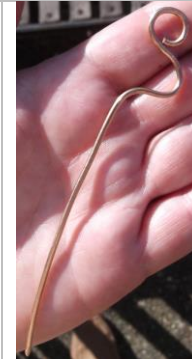
Flint hand axe

One of the most common tools of the Palaeolithic, primarily a butchery tool.



Bronze pin

A ring headed, swan neck pin, used to fasten clothing during the later Bronze Age and early Iron Age.



Iron snips

An early form of scissors dating from the Iron Age. A larger version was used for shearing sheep.



Bone Needle

Used for sewing fabric and leather items.



Antler hammer

A tool used in the manufacture of flint implements.
